Minutes Regular Meeting Wednesday, May 9, 2018

1. Meeting was opened at 1:00 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. Environmental Compliance Report - Todd Melanson

A document titled "Environmental Compliance Manager's Report Water Commissioners' Meeting: 05/09/2018" was distributed and supporting documentation was reviewed, discussed, and questions addressed item-by-item. The report included the following items: Energy Update, District Issues, Town Issues, Water Conservation and Withdrawal, and Outreach.

Mr. Melanson requested approval from the Board to submit a letter to support the Town of Chelmsford in their pursuit of Municipal Vulnerability Preparedness Grant. Based on the vulnerability map, the District's facilities and infrastructure are in areas that are most vulnerable and could be affected by flooding. With this vulnerability, the District would look most favorably on any program that would help the Town and the District plan to mitigate the effects for climate change. As such, the Chelmsford Water District would like to support and encourages the town's commitment to this effort. The District looks forward to participating in partnership with the Town in the Community Resilience Building Workshop.

Mr. Harrington made a motion to submit the letter to support the Town in their pursuit of Municipal Vulnerability Preparedness Grant with the District involvement. After some discussion, Chelmsford Water Department will contract Smart Choice Landscaping for seasonal work.

Also, Chelmsford Water Department will contract Arbor East Tree Service, Inc. to take down trees and remove wood and brush.
